

# Lake Management Key Timelines

Approximate timelines of when various activities recur every year.

## Quarter 1 (Jan-Mar)

- Start equipment refurbishments, if approved
- DNR Planning grant deadline Feb 1 2020 & 2021
- Chemical application award
- Chemical application permit – publish in paper
- Weed harvesting permit 2 year permit, if needed
- Award for weed harvesting
- Award for equipment support and storage (3 year)
- Annual Stevens Point conference (March or April)
- Publication of spring newsletter, if planned
- Include Call for Board candidates

Get tax role mailing labels from Sue Finster @ county (~\$20)

## Quarter 2 (Apr-Jun)

- Spring lake quality survey
- Chemical application
- Goose management permits
- Start equipment deployment and season preparations
- Goose egg oiling
- Spring fish stocking
- Annual budget audit
- Start regular season weed harvesting

## Quarter 3 (Jul-Sep)

- Goose harvesting
- Approval of budget detail by Board
- Publication of fall newsletter, annual meeting and next year's budget
  - Get member spreadsheet for annual meeting fm Finster @ county
- Fall grant cycle deadline Aug 1 for winter period
- Annual meeting, election of open Board commissioners and summary budget approval
- Bid, if needed, and award annual insurance contract
- Start of bog harvesting

## Quarter 4 (Oct-Dec)

- Fall fish stocking
- Fall lake quality survey
- DNR Management Grant deadline Dec 10, 2020
- Winter preparation and storage of equipment
- Submit tax levy
- Bids for harvesting and equipment support (3 years optional)
- Bid and award any equipment refurbishment, if approved
- Bid and award any equipment storage (variable to 3 years)
- Bid, if needed, for 3 year chemical application

## Long Term

- Long Range lake management plan (good for 5-10 years)
  - Prepare in 2021 / Due in 2022
- Harvesting permit – last approved: 2016, due next: 2021
- 10 year Bog Permit due Sep 2023
- Worksheet for Chemical Aquatic Plant Treatment (form 3200-A4)
  - Due every 5 years. 2018, next one in 2023
